Key Activities

Today we started with recapping from last week message centered around "Phila Love" (love for a brother). Students gave multiple examples on how they attempted to be Phila love this past week. After initial discussion we split the group into two teams and played an epic game of Capture the Flag. This game challenged leadership skills, strategic planning, and unselfish acts of kindness to retrieve one teammate out of harm's way. This game flowed nicely into the day's message "Agape Love" (unconditional love). Students learned when we were still powerless, Christ died for the ungodly. We dove into how humans show love to one another and how God shows unconditional love to us. Our game allowed us to give friendly examples of how we as people often base our love for one another through validations.
